The Lake of the Arbuckles Watershed Association (LAWA) is a group of landowners, community members, and partners working together to protect and improve the health of our watershed. Membership in LAWA means joining a network of neighbors who care about the same things you do—protecting the places we call home.

We offer several membership options to fit the needs of individuals, partners, and businesses.

Individual Landowner Membership – \$25/year

Our Individual Membership is perfect for landowners and community members who want to get involved. Members have the chance to network with other landowners, access equipment and watershed coordinators, and take part in educational opportunities. Individual members are also eligible to serve on the LAWA Board of Directors, providing a direct voice in shaping the direction of our association.

Gold Partner Membership – \$50/year

The Gold Partner Membership is designed for those who want to deepen their engagement. Gold Partners receive recognition for their support, a letter of support from LAWA for conservation or research efforts, and valuable opportunities to collaborate with other members on projects or grants—all in addition to the educational resources available to every member.

Platinum Corporate Membership – \$250/year

Platinum members receive public recognition as key partners, a letter of support to strengthen future projects or collaborations, and opportunities to connect with other members for potential research and grant partnerships, while also benefiting from our education programs.
